Can we really read that many books before kindergarten?

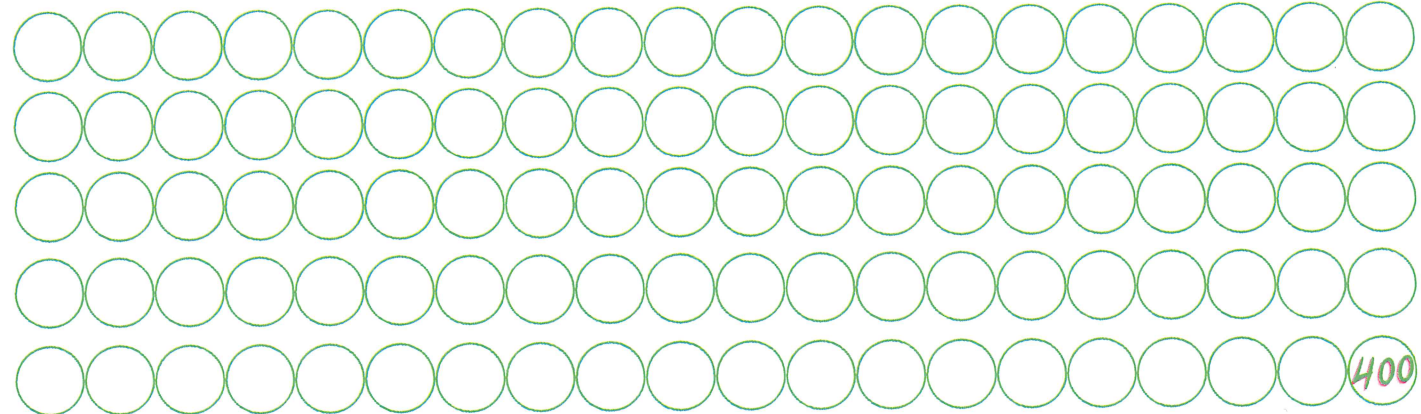
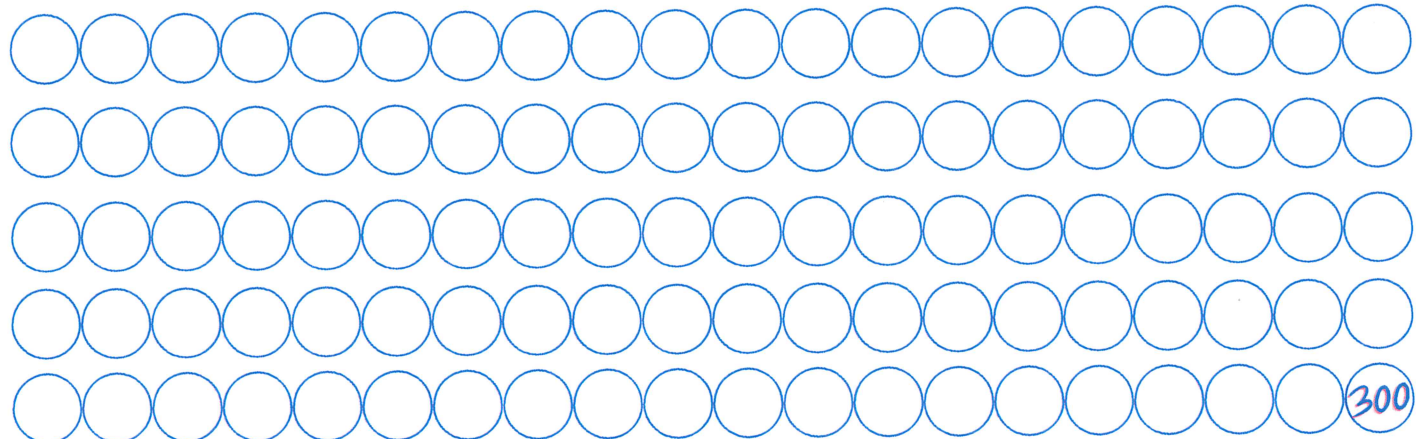
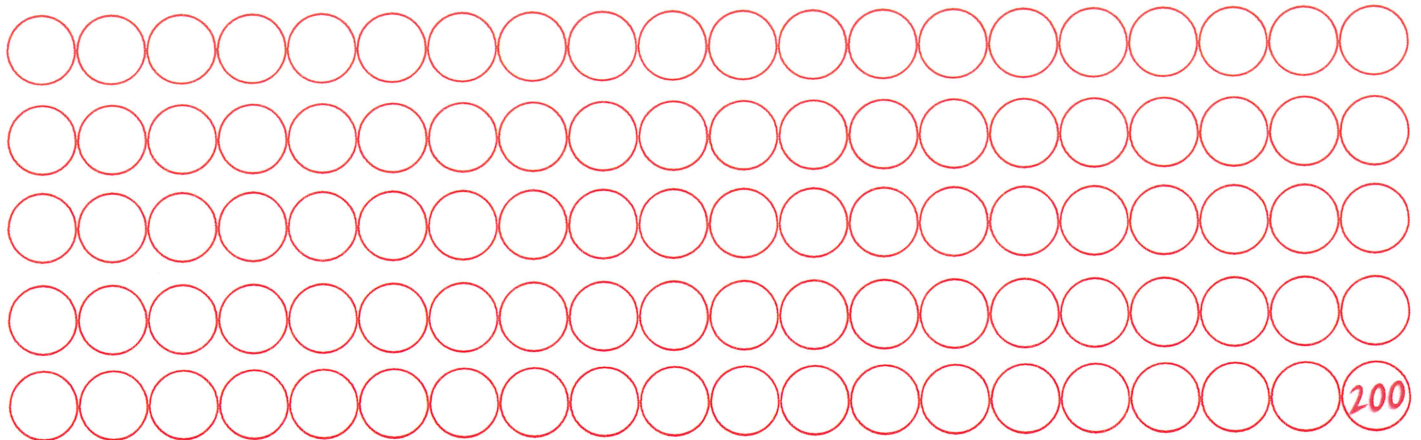
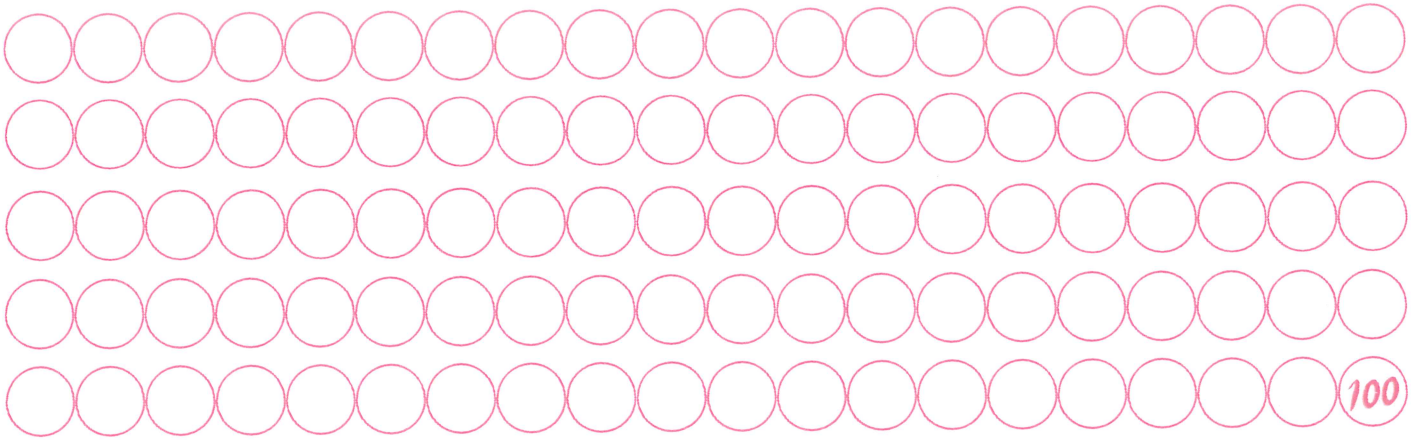
Yes! If you read one book a day you can complete the program within three years.

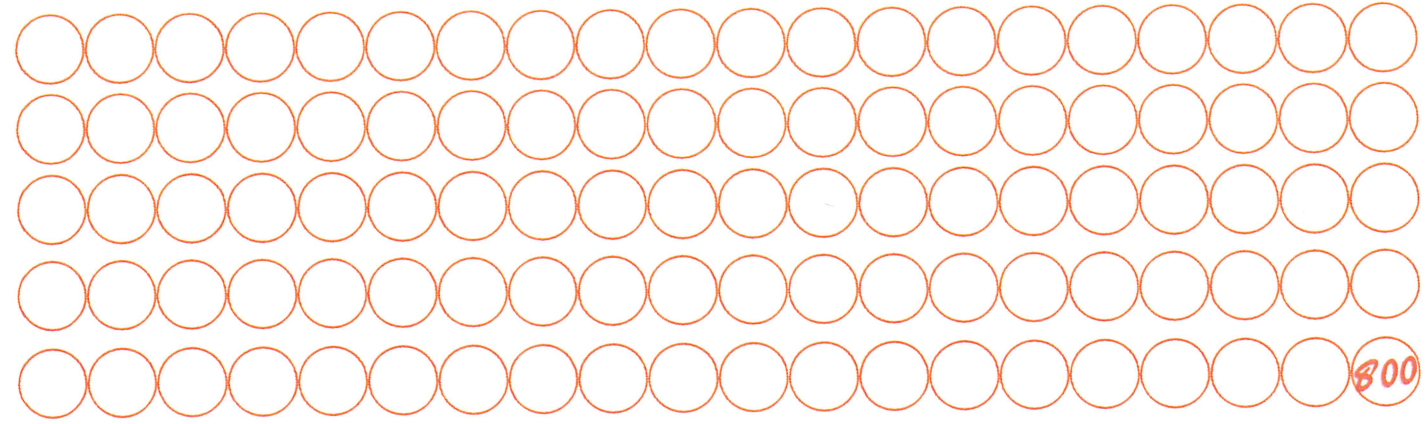
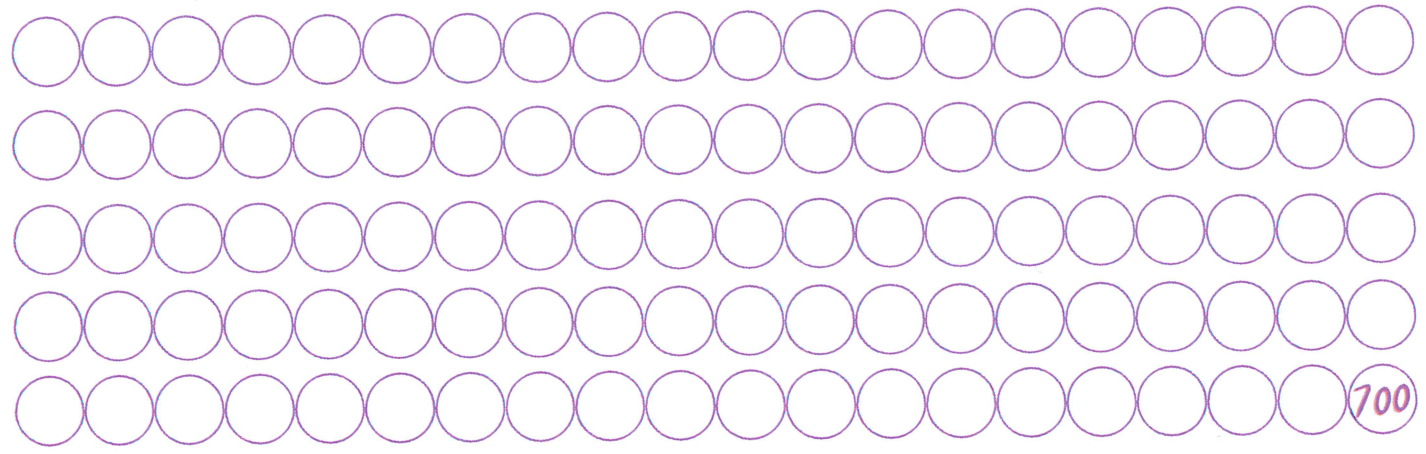
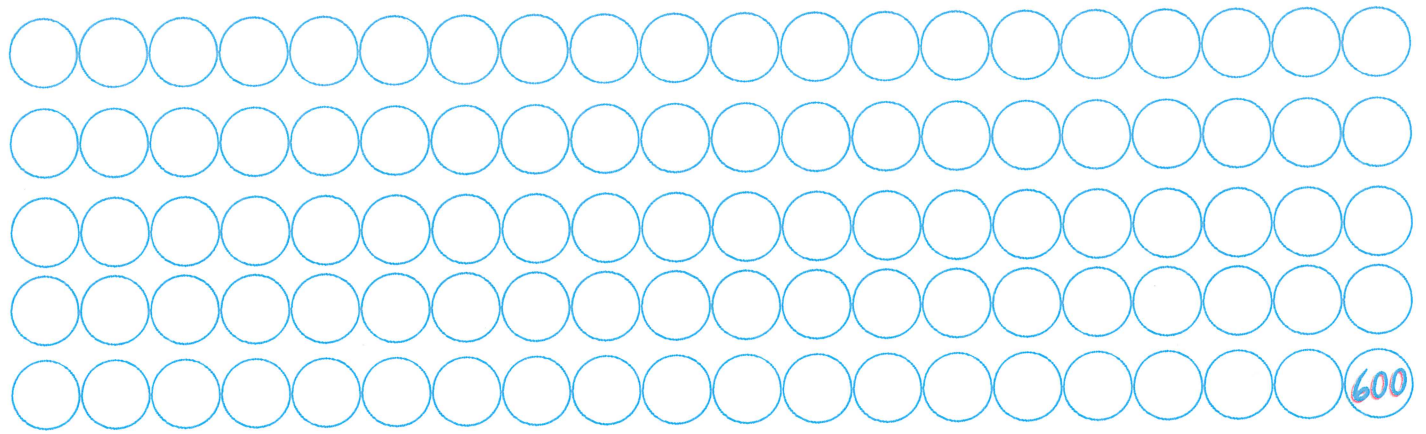
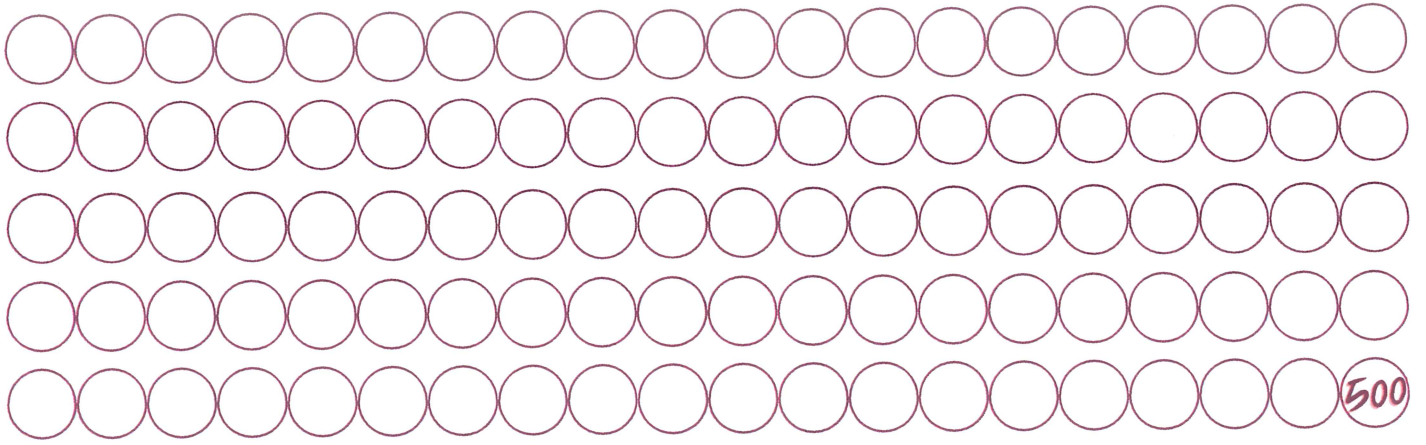
Can other people read to my child besides me?
